Budget

TWO-star Timhotel Gare Du Nord – from

£62 per person per night, b/b at weekends in Oct/November.

Four-star **Le Claridge** – from 239 euros per night for a studio in early November.

Le Claridge is right on the Champs Elysées and used to be a celebrity hotel with quite a history. Now it is luxury serviced apartments and is perfect for exploring the city.

Serviced apartments are becoming more and more popular against the traditional hotels as they offer freedom and flexibility.

They are especially popular for families and groups of friends travelling together.
